

Springing into technology!

A NEW WAY OF TRAINING

ON-DEMAND LEARNING

Courses are being built with access in mind. Being able to take your time, absorbing information at a pace that is comfortable, and being able to access training outside of traditional business hours are a priority in today's world. We are designing courses that allow content to be delivered online at whatever pace or time of day is convenient for the trainee. Questions can be emailed to the trainer and video instruction can be delivered to clarify or go further in depth as needed.

In addition to online opportunities, we have created courses that offer BPI Certification or CEU's that can be offered at a time that works best for you. You can call and request the course you need, the dates you'd like to attend, and whether you'd like to include online instruction as a resource or not. We currently offer this option for BPI IDL Certification, Venting to Daylight, Dense Packing Insulation, and Air Sealing skills training, but our library of courses is constantly expanding.
