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within the State of Louisiana; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing credits to Arbours at Lake Charles, LLC; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.

(ACTION) Resolution of intention to issue not exceeding Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for Bayou D'Arbonne Retirement Village located at 700 West Pinecrest Road, West Monroe, Ouachita Parish, Louisiana, in one or more series to finance the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a multifamily housing development within the State of Louisiana; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing credits to Bayou D'Arbonne Retirement Village; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.

(ACTION) Resolution of intention to issue not exceeding Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000) Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for Cypress Court located at the west side of Cedar Lane near the intersection of Mulberry Street, Ponchatoula, Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana, in one or more series to finance the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a multifamily housing development within the State of Louisiana; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing credits to Cypress Court; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.
- (\$8,000,000) Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for Federal City Building 10 located at 2440 Guadalcanal Street, New Orleans, Orleans Parish, Louisiana, in one or more series to finance the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a multifamily housing development within the State of Louisiana; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing credits to Federal City Building 10; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.
- 13. (ACTION) Resolution of intention to issue not exceeding Forty-Two Million Dollars (\$42,000,000) Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for Cypress at Ardendale Phase I located at 1701 N. Ardenwood Drive, Baton Rouge, East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana 70806, in one or more series to finance the acquisition, construction, and equipping of a multifamily housing development within the State of Louisiana; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing credits to Cypress at Ardendale



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Phase I; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.
