(ACTION) Resolution of intention to issue not exceeding Eight Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000) Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds for GWT Housing Partners, LLC, in one or more series, to finance the acquisition, rehabilitation, construction and equipping of a multifamily housing development consisting of 100 units located at 4619 Luciana Circle, Shreveport, Caddo Parish, Louisiana 71109; to establish the maximum qualified basis and low-income housing tax credits to GWT Housing Partners, LLC; to authorize the staff and counsel to prepare the forms of such documents and agreements as may be necessary to allocate 4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits to such facilities; and to provide for other matters in connection therewith.
