



# *Louisiana Housing Corporation*

The following resolution was offered by Board Member Brandon O. Williams and seconded by Board Member Wendy Gentry:

## **RESOLUTION**

**Resolution adopting a Short-Term LHC Operating Budget in the amount of \$11.5M for the period of July 01, 2024 - September 01, 2024, as related to the LHC Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025; in the interim, there are to be no new hires or pay increases without Board approval; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.**

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Housing Corporation (“LHC” or Corporation”) was created by and pursuant to the Louisiana Housing Corporation Act contained in Chapter 3-G of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (R.S. 40:600.86 through R.S. 40:600.111); and

**WHEREAS**, the LHC, as authorized by the State of Louisiana, shall establish its own operating budget.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of the Louisiana Housing Corporation, acting as the governing authority of said Corporation, that:

**SECTION 1.** The Louisiana Housing Corporation adopts a Short-Term Operating Budget in the amount \$11.5M for the period of July 01, 2024 – September 01, 2024, as related to the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025. Additionally, in the interim, there are to be no new hires or pay increases without Board approval.

**SECTION 2.** The LHC staff and counsel are authorized and directed to prepare such documents and agreements as may be necessary to implement the Louisiana Housing

Corporation Fiscal Year 2025 Short-Term LHC Operating Budget in the amount of \$11.5 for the period of July 01, 2024 – September 01, 2024, as related to the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025 Operating Budget.

**SECTION 3.** The LHC is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed the ability as may be necessary to create, change, amend, and revise any existing documents and/or commitments to the Louisiana Housing Corporation Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025 Operating Budget, the terms of which are to be consistent with the provisions of this resolution.

**SECTION 4.** The Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Executive Director, and/or Secretary of the LHC are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to execute any forms and/or documents required to be executed on behalf of and in the name of the LHC, the terms of which are to be consistent with the provisions of this resolution.
