The following resolution was offered by Board Member Richard A. Winder and seconded by Board Member Steven J. Hattier:

RESOLUTION

A resolution to approve and authorize the Louisiana Housing Corporation ("Corporation") to award funds to the highest scoring proposer(s) for the HOME American Rescue Plan Program ("HOME-ARP") Services and Non-Profits Assistance NOFA; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Housing Corporation ("LHC" or "Corporation") was created by and pursuant to the Louisiana Housing Corporation Act contained in Chapter 3-G of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (R.S. 40:600.86 through R.S. 40:600.111);

WHEREAS, the LHC, as authorized by the State of Louisiana pursuant to R.S. 40:600.91(A), shall have the powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of the LHC Act;

WHEREAS, the LHC Board of Directors and staff have recognized the need for the provision of HOME-ARP approved homelessness assistance and non-profits assistance through tenant-based rental assistance and supportive services; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2024, the LHC released the final version of its Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA") for HOME-ARP Services and Non-Profits Assistance, which invited qualified applicants to submit proposals for consideration of funding to provide the HOME-ARP approved services; and

WHEREAS, such proposals have been received, reviewed, graded and ranked.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Louisiana Housing Corporation, acting as the governing authority of said Corporation, that:

SECTION 1. The recommendation of LHC staff for the selection of the highest scoring proposer(s) to provide HOME-ARP approved services, in accordance with the requirements listed

in the NOFA for HOME-ARP Services and Non-Profits Assistance, for the Louisiana Housing Corporation is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Executive Director, and/or Secretary are hereby authorized to select and approve the highest scoring proposer(s), to provide HOME-ARP approved services, in accordance with the requirements listed in the NOFA for HOME-ARP Services and Non-Profits Assistance, and approve any other action necessary or convenient to accomplish the objectives of this resolution.

SECTION 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Executive Director, and/or Secretary of the Corporation are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to execute any forms and/or documents required to be executed on behalf of and in the name of the Corporation, the terms of which are to be consistent with the provisions of this resolution.
