RESOLUTION

Resolution recognizing in perpetuity the month of October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Housing Corporation (the "Corporation") was created as a public body corporate and politic of the State of Louisiana pursuant to Act 408 of the 2011 Louisiana Legislature, contained in Chapter 3-G of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended and codified as Louisiana Revised Statute §40:600.86 through 600.11 (the "LHC Act"); and

WHEREAS, domestic violence is a serious crime that affects people of all races, ages, gender identities, and socioeconomic backgrounds, and it is a pervasive issue in our community and across the nation;

WHEREAS, the impact of domestic violence is felt not only by the victims but also by their families, friends, and the community at large, leading to long-term physical, emotional, and psychological consequences;

WHEREAS, raising awareness about domestic violence is crucial to preventing it, supporting survivors, and holding offenders accountable;

WHEREAS, organizations and individuals across the country have dedicated their efforts to providing support, education, and advocacy for those affected by domestic violence;

WHEREAS, in perpetuity the month of October has been designated as National Domestic Violence Awareness Month to bring attention to the issue and to promote resources and support for victims and survivors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Louisiana Housing Corporation (the "Board"), acting as the governing authority of said Corporation, recognizes in perpetuity the month of October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

SECTION 1. The Louisiana Housing Corporation encourages all citizens to participate in activities and programs that promote awareness, education, and support for domestic violence prevention and intervention;

SECTION 2. The Louisiana Housing Corporation supports the efforts of domestic violence service providers, advocates, and community partners who work tirelessly to assist victims and survivors and to prevent domestic violence in our community.

SECTION 3 The Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, and/or Executive Counsel are authorized and directed to prepare the forms of such notices, documents, and/or agreements as may be necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.
