NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Louisiana Housing Corporation (the “**Corporation**”), will conduct a public hearing on October 21, 2024 at 10:00 A.M., at the offices of the Louisiana Housing Corporation, 2415 Quail Drive, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70808 to hear any objections to the issuance of not exceeding \$18,000,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Parkwood Place Apartments Project) in one or more series (the “**Bonds**”) pursuant to provisions of Chapter 3-G of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (the “**Act**”), and other constitutional and statutory authority supplemental thereto, to provide a financing with respect to the acquisition, construction, and/or equipping of a multifamily housing development as follows:

Description of Project Type: Parkwood Place Apartments Project, consisting of a 90-unit multifamily housing development (the “**Development**”), located on multiple contiguous lots within the Parkwood Place Subdivision in Houma, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana encompassing 8.5 acres of land as follows:

- (i) 202, 203, and 207 Fleur De Lis Drive
- (ii) 211, 215, 221, 225, 231, 235, 239, 245, 249, 401, and 405 Saints Circle
- (iii) 202, 203, 206, 207, 210, 214, 215, 218, 222, 223, 226, 227, 230, 231, 234, 235, 238, 239, 242, 243, 246, 247, 250, 251, 254, 255, 258, 259, 262, 263, 266, 267, 270, and 271 Super Bowl Drive

Maximum Bond Principal: \$18,000,000 for a project cost of approximately \$23,785,050

Initial Owner/operator of the Development: SBP Parkwood, LLC

The Bonds will be limited obligations of the Corporation secured solely by revenues and moneys derived by the Corporation from or with respect to the Development.

The public and interested parties are invited to attend and present oral or written comments at the public hearing regarding the residential development and the issuance of the Bonds.
