Program Promotion

We are working on educational programs for elementary and secondary students that help them grasp Weatherization and the benefits of our program. In the future, we are hoping to introduce a Career and Technical Education course to high schools in the area to help educate, train, and prepare interested students. We hosted a small group of students in January and sent them home with a document summarizing the benefits of Weatherization and with contact information for their local WAP Agency, Quad Area CAA. The kids had a great time!



The training center is developing consumable props that allow trainees to practice skills and get their hands on equipment and tools that are appropriate for these tasks. Here's a detailed look at a new prop created to train crew on venting to daylight. Trainees practice lining up ducts in the attic where the holes should be placed, marking the hole from inside the attic, cutting the hole in the roof, shingle work to place the vent cover properly, sealing the vent cover thoroughly, repairing all shingle work thoroughly, and connecting the duct to the cover.
